
Trimley St Mary Parish Council

Warm Homes Loans: There are loans available through Suffolk County Council for insulation and other work to improve thermal efficiency of homes. These are interest free loans, for £2000 to £15000, payable over a maximum period of 7 years. There is a £3 million fund, and the money is available from 01 November 2024, financed by the Government. Trimley rail station usage figures for the year to 31 March 2024 were published recently and are:

Trimley 45,948 + 9% on last year

These are the highest recorded figures since at least 1996 and probably since well before then.
