- 3. Citizens Advice East Suffolk was formed in 2023, following the merger of Felixstowe, Leiston & Saxmundham and Lowestoft. In 2023/2024:
 - 8,547 people sought advice
 - 35,000 issues advised on
 - 3.7% clients are under the age of 24
 - 16.7% are over the age of 70
 - 47% have long term health conditions
 - 9% are disabled
 - 33% of issues relate to Benefits and Universal Credit
 - 17% of issues relate to Housing issues
 - Achieved just over £2.3 million of financial gains for our clients
