Remembrance: Armistice Day: On November the 11th at 10.50am a short service with Phil the Bugler playing the last post.

A dedication by Canon Sharron Coburn to the newly refurbished sign in memory of one of the founders of the peace sign Peter Gosling RN which was installed September 1995 50 years after the end of WW2. Peter passed away August 2024 aged 98 and was a D-day veteran. A wreath will be laid by Tristan Gale on behalf of our residents and a class of children from year 6 from our village school will be in attendance and will lay a wreath made by the school children and read out a poem. WHITE LINES: Following a consultation with residents in the village, the Parish Council have agreed to putting white lines around junctions in Station Road at Addington Road, The Avenue, Second Avenue and New Road.

It is hoped that the lines will deter motorists from parking within 10m of those junctions which has for a long time now

caused obstructed view of people and vehicles entering and leaving, and has resulted in a number of 'near miss' incidents. The Parish Council will seek to finalise the arrangements at their next meeting.
